 GUIDELINES FOR GIFTS OF TOYS

Children's Ages	ACCEPTABLE TOYS
1-3	No-spill bubbles, plastic blocks & stacking rings, dolls, mobiles, non-cloth cradle gyms, crayons, Fisher Price toys, play telephones, trucks, sight and sound books, stacking and sorting toys, board & push button books, Lullabies and Classical music CDs, infant aquariums, non-cloth rattles, plastic infant links, younger age puzzles, musical and/or light-up toys, new spoons & sippy cups
4-8	Cars, trucks, paint sets, play doctor kits, play cash registers, dollhouse people, animal toys, I SPY books, Legos, toy trains, Board games such as: Connect Four, Guess Who, Sorry and UNO
8-12	Art supplies and craft kits, colored pencils & markers, jewelry making kits, Matchbox cars, 500 – 100 piece puzzles, non-violent action figures, Superheroes, Game Systems and Games rated E, Playstation II, Nintendo Wii, Wii Fit, PSP, Nintendo DS, Gameboys , Board games such as: Guess Who, Uno, Scattegories, Connect Four, Sorry, and Playing Cards, New DVD Movies: G – PG
13-Adult	Art supplies and craft kits, glass bead kits, nail polish sets, hair brush sets & accessories, scrapbook supplies, photo albums, stamp kits, journals, stationary sets, sports team items, new magazines, board games such as: Jenga, Pictionary, Trivia Games, Scrabble, Backgammon, chess, Othello, games rated T for Teen, portable DVD players, hand-held game systems , Portable CD players and Cd's, New DVD Movies: PG13
Gift Cards	ITunes, Target, Best Buy, Borders, Barnes & Noble, Walmart, & Amazon

(**Bolded** items are always high in demand and recommended)

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS: (PLEASE DO NOT DONATE)

- ◆ **NO USED TOYS** of any kind are accepted due to infection control guidelines, as they could be of harmful to sick children. This includes **NO USED** stuffed animals.
- ◆ No tiny choke able toys or **cloth** toys.
- ◆ Please do **NOT** wrap toys – the items must be checked before being given to a child.
- ◆ Other **UNACCEPTABLE** items include computers, artwork (for display), and hair donations.
